The scholarship will be given as a cash grant in an amount at the discretion of the Board of Directors but not to exceed \$500.00.

All recipients must write an acknowledgement of receipt and a follow-up letter of their progress and/or experience in their chosen Scottish art for the publication in the House of Gordon USA publication, *"In The House!"*.
