

## Charles O. Gordon Memorial Scholarship Application

The House of Gordon USA offers the Charles O. Gordon Memorial Scholarship to those who wish to further their tutelage in the Scottish Arts including, but not limited to: piping, highland drumming, highland dance, fiddle, heavy athletics, and Gaelic language study. Applicants must be at least ten (10) years of age and involved in learning a Scottish Art.

Applicants do not need to be a member of or descendant of a member of the House of Gordon USA. Scholarships are granted based on the need and commitment of the applicant. The scholarship will be given as a cash grant in an amount at the discretion of the Board of Directors but not to exceed \$500.00.

All recipients must write an acknowledgement of receipt and a follow-up letter of their progress and/or experience in their chosen Scottish art for the publication in the House of Gordon USA publication, "In The House!".
